



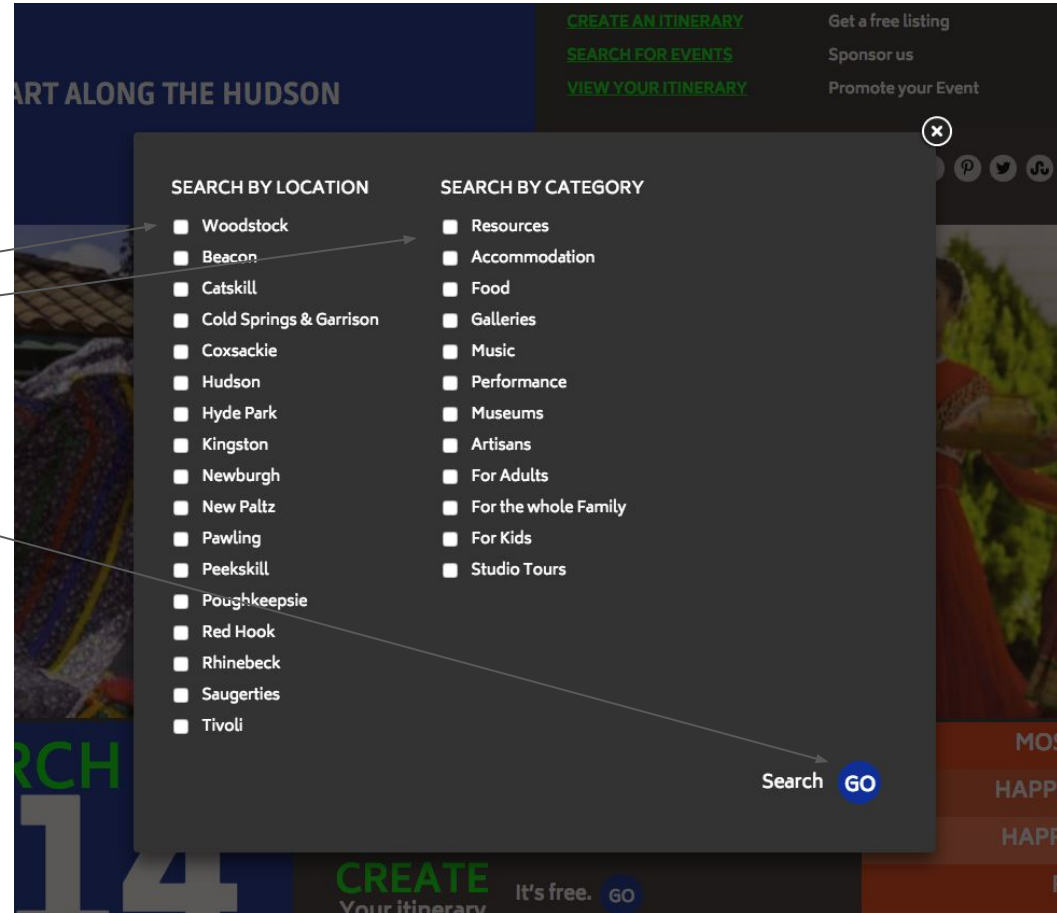

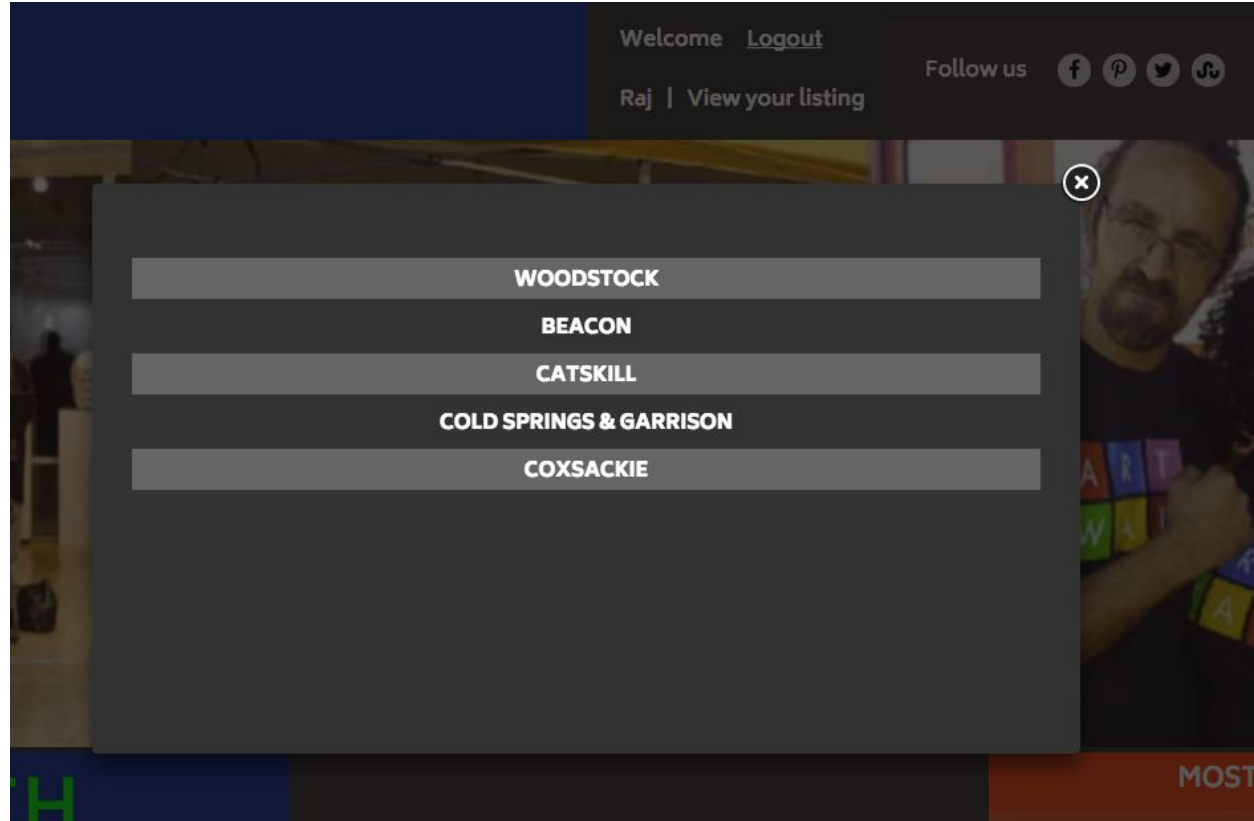
# How to search listings

# How to search listings

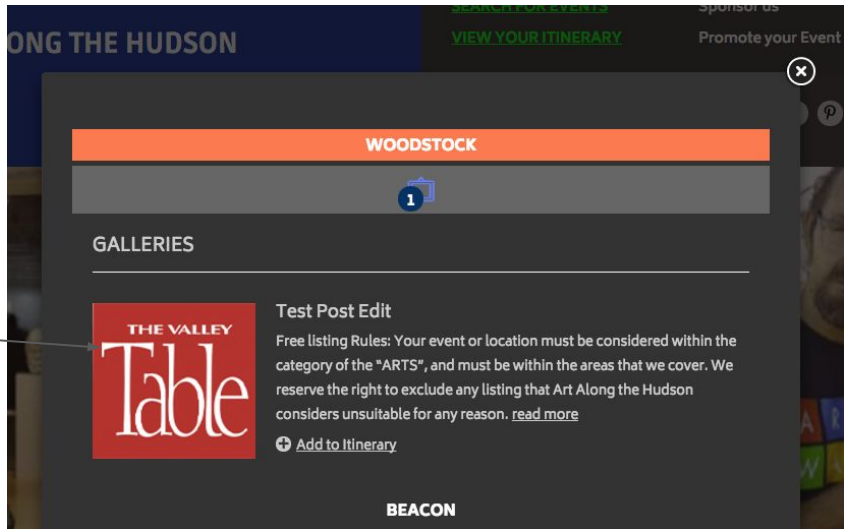
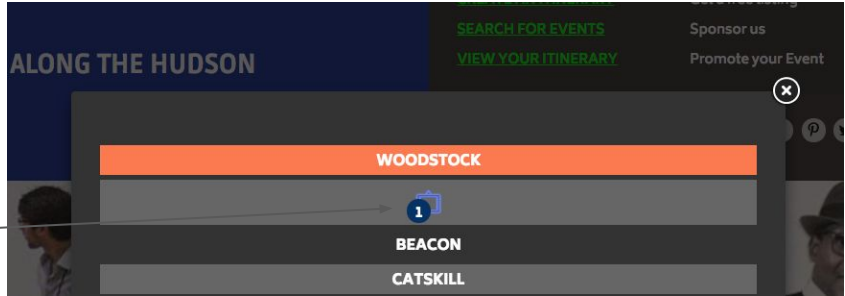
- You will now see your search results





And click GO

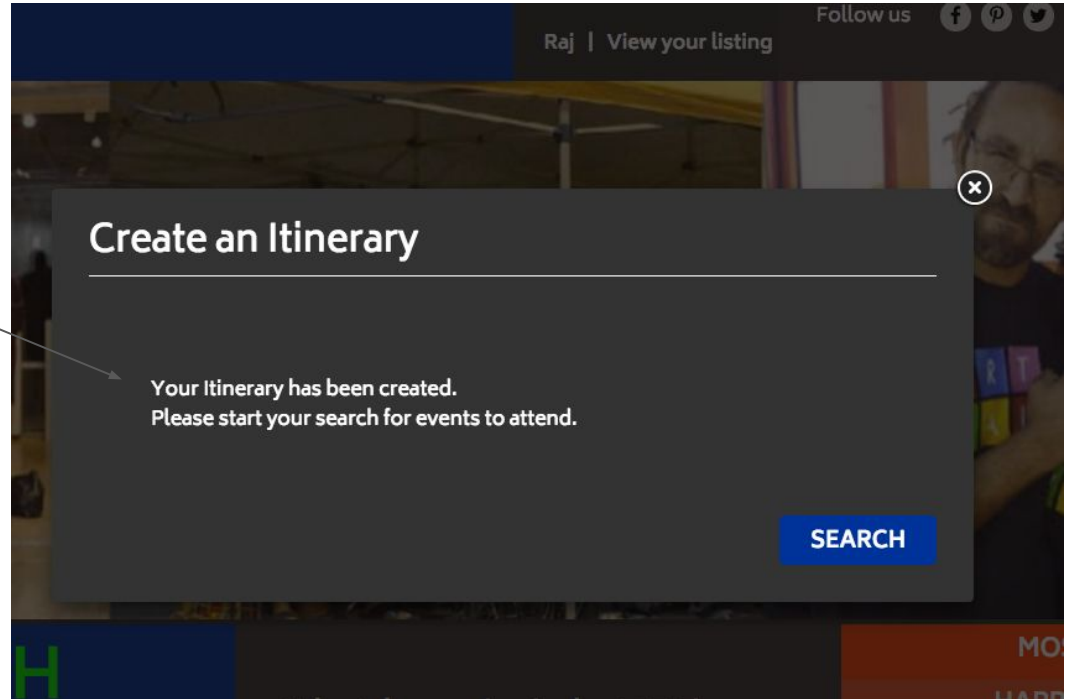
